DRAFT BYE-LAWS FOR REGISTRATION AND CONTROL OF DOGS IN MATHURA CANTONMENT

Under Section 290 of Sub Section 1 to 6 of the Cantonments Act,2006 (41 of 2006), the Mathura Cantonment Board with the approval of the Central Government hereby makes the following ye-laws namely:

- 1. <u>Short title and commencement</u>: The Bye-laws for Registration and Control of Dogs kept in Mathura Cantonment 2024.
- 2. It shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.
- 3. **Definitions** This bye- laws, unless the context other-wise required :
- (a) "The Board" means the Cantonment Board, Mathura;
- (b) "The Act" means the Cantonment Act;
- (c) "The Chief Executive Officer" means the Chief Executive Officer of the Cantonment Board.
- 4. Every dog of the age of three months or over kept within cantonment limits shall be registered in a register prescribed by the Board, such registration shall hold good for a year:

Provided that no registration shall be necessary if the dog is kept within the Cantonment for a period not exceeding three months.

- 5. The Officer Commanding of each military unit in the Cantonment shall cause to be registered all dogs, kept in the lines occupied by his unit and shall forward to the Chief Executive Officer quarterly on April 1, July 1, October 1 and January 1 a list of all such dogs and their owners.
- 6. All persons in the Cantonment residing outside military lines who own or keep dogs shall register them at office of the Cantonment Board.
- 7. Every registered dog shall wear a collar to which shall be attached a metal token issued by the Chief Executive Officer for which a following fee will be paid per annum:

Prevailing actual cost of token will be charged and will bear the same number as the one in the register. If a token is lost, a duplicate may be obtained on payment of prevailing cost of token. The annual fee shall be revised periodically by the Board.

- 8. Any dog which is liable to registration but has not been registered or is not wearing the prescribed metal token shall, is found in any public place may be detained by the Cantonment authority.
- 9. A fee of Rs. 200/- per day shall be charged for such detention and any such dog shall be liable to be disposed of if found to be defected with some contagious disease, as per Rules unless it is claimed.

PENALTY

10. In exercise of the power conferred by Section 349 of the Act, the board hereby directs that a breach of byelaws for above shall be punishable with a fine one thousand rupees and in the case of a continuing contravention with an additional fine, which may extend to two thousand rupees.
